

Business Planning - Teacher Guide

1 hour in total (45 min session plus 15 minute Q&A)

Aims

- This workshop will support teams to think about the key considerations when developing an idea into a business, using a business model canvas (or similar template format).
- It will help teams to understand the importance of refining their business model based on user feedback and how they can capture this during key stages of development.
- They will leave the session with a better understanding of what a potential investor would look for in a business and how to apply this to their own ideas.

Resources

- Value proposition Ad-libs (blank PDF supplied) - ideally print one per team member (also fine to just have one copy for the whole team).
- Value Proposition example Netflix (PDF supplied) - you may want to print a copy of this for reference. PLEASE DONT SHOW THE TEAM THIS BEFORE INSTRUCTED.
- Lean Canvas (blank PDF supplied) - print one per team (ideally on A3 or large format but A4 is fine).

- A blank sheet of A4 paper for each team member
- Pens/pencils (ideally including a marker/felt-tip/sharpie)
