

## ***Security & Ethics - Teacher Guide***

1 hour in total (45 min session plus 15 minute Q&A)

### ***Aims***

- This workshop will help teams to understand how their ideas (product or solution) uses different types of data, and the importance of thinking about privacy for their users.
- The workshop should encourage teams to consider the wider ethical implications of technology and help them to apply this to their own ideas.
- The teams should leave the session with an understanding of the key security and ethical considerations surrounding their ideas.
